Hello, I am Evonne Richards, Community Health Education Specialist and Instructional Designer for the Community Health Worker online training program. The West Virginia School of Osteopathic Medicine complies with the latest online learning guidelines, the Web Content Accessibility guidelines, or WCAG 2.0 or also known as CAG 2.0. The CHERP online learning content has been developed using “A” or “AA” standards. What does that mean for you? Content has been designed for someone visually or hearing impaired or who may have physical barriers to gain the same level of access to learning as their counterparts. How have we done this? Video transcripts are available and content transcripts are available within each unit. Learners can enlarge text on the screen and within exams. Hyperlinks are detailed with the names and are underlined as well as using traditional color. High level of contrast between content background and text is used for best visibility. Learners who have documented barriers may also request accommodation for testing. PDF transcripts for each unit are available to download for use by acceptability devices such as screen readers.
